Every Student, Every School, Every Day

There are still too many children arriving to school late and having unauthorised absences. This has a negative impact on learning of the child that is late but, it also disrupts the learning of the other children in the class.

Letters will be going out to the parents of all children who have attendance less than 95%, and you may also be referred to the Education Welfare Officers in Southwark. It is important that we get children in to good habits which will set them up to be successful adults in the future.



I would like to remind all parents that we have a school uniform here at St. Joseph's and parents need to check that their children come into school with the right equipment. Children should be wearing plain black school shoes and not trainers or boots. If your child has long hair it should be tied back and out of their face. Hair accessories, such as ribbons and bobbles should be uniform colours. Blue, black, white, or yellow. Hair extensions should not be too long and should be the **same colour** as the child's natural hair. This should also be tied back during school.

Children are allowed to a single gold stud. – No hoops, or stars or any other shaped earrings are allowed.

The Infant school uses a red school bag and Junior School use a Blue school bag with the school logo. Please ensure that your child comes to school in the correct uniform and maintain the standards in the school.
