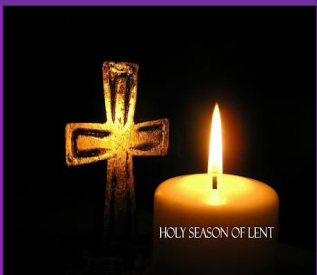


PRAYER To SAINT JOSEPH
